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(10) CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION GRADUATION PATHWAY OPTION.-Beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, a student is eligible to complete an alternative pathway to earning a standard high school diploma through the Career and Technical Education (CTE) pathway option. Receipt of a standard high school diploma awarded through the CTE pathway option requires 10 the student's successful completion of at least 18 credits. A
