if any structural distress is identified during phase one. The inspector in charge of a phase two inspection must be a licensed engineer or licensed architect who has a minimum of 5 years of experience designing the primary structural components of buildings and a minimum of 5 years of experience inspecting structural components of existing buildings of a similar size,

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scope, and type of construction. A phase two inspection may involve destructive or nondestructive testing at the inspector's direction. The inspection may be as extensive or as limited as necessary to fully assess damaged areas of the building in order to confirm that the building is safe for its intended use or to recommend a program for fully assessing and repairing damaged portions of the building. When determining testing locations, the inspector must give preference to locations that are the least disruptive and most easily repairable while still being representative of the structure.
