- 1. The governing boards shall consider all of the following criteria in designating a wetland for inclusion on the list:
- a. The ecological value of the wetland, as determined by the physical and biological components of the environmental system.



12 b. The effect of the wetland on water quality and flood 13 mitigation. 14 c. The ecosystem restoration value of the wetland. 15 d. The inherent susceptibility of the wetland to 16 development due to its geographical location or natural 17 aesthetics. 18 2. Before adopting or amending its list of critical 19 wetlands, each governing board must notify the owner of any 2.0 property that the district contemplates including on the list. 21 At any time, an owner who wishes to have his or her property 22 removed from the list must submit by certified mail to the 23 district a letter requesting such removal. The letter must 24 indicate that the owner wishes for his or her property to be 25 removed from the list and must sufficiently identify such 26 property to the governing board.
