Remove lines 54-79 and insert:

7 2. As to the tuition differential, if the actuarial 8 reserve is less than 5 percent of the expected liabilities of 9 the trust fund, the board shall pay the state universities 5.5 10 percent above the amount assessed base rate for the tuition differential fee in the preceding fiscal year. If the actuarial 11 reserve is between 5 percent and 6 percent of the expected 12 liabilities of the trust fund, the board shall pay the state 13 14 universities 6 percent above the amount assessed base rate for 15 the tuition differential fee in the preceding fiscal year. 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17 the expected liabilities of the trust fund, the board shall pay 18 the state universities 6.5 percent above the amount assessed 19 base rate for the tuition differential fee in the preceding fiscal year. If the actuarial reserve is equal to or greater 20 than 7.5 percent of the expected liabilities of the trust fund, 21 22 the board shall pay the state universities 7 percent above the 23 amount assessed base rate for the tuition differential fee in 24 the preceding fiscal year.

3. As to local fees, the board shall pay the state
universities 5 percent above the amount assessed for local fees
in the preceding fiscal year.

4. As to dormitory fees, the board shall pay the state
universities 6 percent above the amount assessed for dormitory
fees in the preceding fiscal year.

31 5. Qualified beneficiaries of advance payment contracts 32 purchased before July 1, 2007, are exempt from paying any 33 tuition differential fee.

(c) Notwithstanding the amount assessed for registration fees, the tuition differential, or local fees, the amount paid by the board to any state university on behalf of a qualified beneficiary of an advance payment contract purchased before <u>July</u> <u>1, 2034</u> July 1, 2024, may not exceed 100 percent of the amount charged by the state university for the aggregate sum of those fees.

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(d) Notwithstanding the amount assessed for dormitory fees, the amount paid by the board to any state university on behalf of a qualified beneficiary of an advance payment contract purchased before <u>July 1, 2034</u> July 1, 2024, may not exceed 100 percent of the amount charged by the state university for dormitory fees.

(e) Notwithstanding the number of credit hours used by a
state university to assess the amount for registration fees,
tuition, tuition differential, or local fees, the amount paid by
the board to any state university on behalf of a qualified
beneficiary of an advance payment contract purchased before July
<u>1, 2034</u> July 1, 2024, may not exceed the number of credit hours
taken by that qualified beneficiary at the state university.

(f) The board shall pay state universities the actual amount assessed in accordance with law for registration fees, the tuition differential, local fees, and dormitory fees for advance payment contracts purchased on or after <u>July 1, 2034</u> July 1, 2024.

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
