A bill to be entitled

An act relating to sudden cardiac arrest informational posters; creating s. 381.991, F.S.; requiring the Department of Health to create an informational poster relating to the treatment of sudden cardiac arrest; providing requirements for such poster; providing definitions; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

- Section 1. Section 381.991, Florida Statutes, is created to read:
- 381.991 Sudden cardiac arrest informational posters.-The Department of Health shall create an informational poster relating to the treatment of sudden cardiac arrest.
 - (1) The poster must:
 - (a) List the signs and symptoms of sudden cardiac arrest.
- (b) Provide steps to take if a person goes into sudden cardiac arrest, including, but not limited to, the following:
 - 1. Call 911.
 - 2. Perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation.
 - 3. Use an automated external defibrillator, if applicable.
- (c) Be publicly displayed in an accessible area of a business or state agency.
 - (2) As used in this section, the term:
- (a) "Business" means a trade or profession with 50 or more employees.
- (b) "State agency" means an entity of the legislative, executive, or judicial branch of state government.
