A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the Medicaid buy-in program for individuals with disabilities; creating s. 409.9141, F.S.; requiring the Agency for Health Care Administration to establish and implement a Medicaid buy-in program for specified individuals with disabilities under certain circumstances; specifying requirements for the program; requiring the agency to seek federal waiver approval or submit any necessary state plan amendments by a specified date; requiring the agency to implement the program upon receiving federal approval; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 409.9141, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

409.9141 Medicaid buy-in program for individuals with disabilities.—

approval through a Medicaid waiver or state plan amendment, implement a Medicaid buy-in program, authorized under the Ticket to Work and Work Incentives Improvement Act of 1999, Pub. L. No. 106-170, and the Balanced Budget Act of 1997, Pub. L. No. 105-33, for individuals with disabilities who are 18 to 64 years of age and whose incomes exceed the maximum income eligibility level for initial enrollment to obtain coverage for medical

(b) The Medicaid buy-in program must provide full Medicaid

assistance under the Medicaid program.

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benefits to eligible individuals and limit any premiums or cost

sharing to a certain percentage of an individual's income, as

determined by the agency.

(2) By October 1, 2024, the agency shall seek federal waiver approval or submit any state plan amendments necessary to implement the Medicaid buy-in program under this section. The agency shall implement the program upon receiving federal approval.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
