104.0614 Harassment of election workers.-

(1) For purposes of this section, the term "election worker" means a member of a county canvassing board or an individual who is an election official or poll worker in

connection with an election conducted in this state.		
(2) A person may not intimidate, threaten, coerce, or		
harass an election worker with the intent to impede or interfere		
with the performance of the election worker's official duties or		
with the intent to retaliate against the election worker for		
performing his or her official duties.		
(3) A person who violates this section commits a		
misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s.		
775.082 or s. 775.083.		
Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2024.
