A bill to be entitled

An act relating to lights on motor vehicles; amending s. 316.2397, F.S.; reclassifying the offense of driving, moving, or causing to be moved a vehicle or equipment with certain lighting on a highway and effects or attempts to effect a stop of another vehicle; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (10) of section 316.2397, Florida Statutes, is amended, and subsection (1) of that section is republished, to read:

316.2397 Certain lights prohibited; exceptions.-

- (1) A person may not drive or move or cause to be moved any vehicle or equipment upon any highway within this state with any lamp or device thereon showing or displaying a red, red and white, or blue light visible from directly in front thereof except for certain vehicles provided in this section.
- (10) (a) A person who violates subsection (1) and in so doing effects or attempts to effect a stop of another vehicle commits a <u>felony misdemeanor</u> of the <u>third first</u> degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2024.
