## BILLS ON THIRD READING

### **CS/SB 692, 1st Eng. (3R) by the Committee on Community Affairs and Senator Bennett—**

**Local Government;** Revising the deadline for submission of a feasibility study of a proposed incorporation of a municipality; providing that qualified electors of certain independent districts may commence a municipal conversion proceeding by filing a petition with the governing body of the independent special district; requiring the governing body to meet, prepare, and approve by resolution, a proposed elector-initiated combined conversion and incorporation plan; prohibiting a conversion process from being initiated for 2 years if the referendum fails, etc. Effective Date: upon becoming a law

*Read the second time and amended on February 14, 2012*

**Exercise of Federal Power;** Urging Congress to honor the provisions of the Constitution of the United States and United States Supreme Court case law which limit the scope and exercise of federal power.

**Recreational Vehicle Dealers;** Authorizing recreational vehicle dealers to obtain certificates of title for recreational vehicles; providing limitations and requirements, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2012

### **CS/SB 396 (2R) by the Committee on Communications, Energy, and Public Utilities, Senator Oelrich and others—**

**Intergovernmental Cooperation;** Authorizing certain parties to an interlocal agreement to conduct public meetings and workshops by means of communications media technology; providing notice requirements; providing a definition, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2012

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Community Affairs; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Communications, Energy, and Public Utilities*

### **CS/CS/SB 406 (2R) by the Committees on Community Affairs, Transportation, Senator Dean and others—**

**Transportation Facility Designations;** Providing honorary designations of certain transportation facilities in specified counties; directing the Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2012

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Transportation; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Community Affairs*

### **CS/SB 440 (2R) by the Committee on Community Affairs and Senator Bennett—**

**Initiatives and Referenda;** Authorizing a local government to retain certain initiatives or referendum processes which were in effect as of a specified date, etc. Effective Date: upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Community Affairs; the Committee on Budget Subcommittee on Transportation, Tourism, and Economic Development Appropriations reports the committee substitute favorably; and withdrawn from the Committee on Budget*

### **CS/SB 514 (2R) by the Committee on Community Affairs, Senator Dean and others—**

**Public Safety;** Providing that a sworn state-certified law enforcement officer under certain circumstances is not included in the definition of the term "911 public safety telecommunicator"; providing that a sworn state-certified law enforcement officer is not required to complete a public safety telecommunication training program under certain circumstances in order to occasionally perform as a public safety telecommunicator; providing that the application fee and examination fee to take the examination that measures the competency and proficiency in the subject material of a public safety telecommunication program do not apply to a sworn state-certified law enforcement officer who occasionally performs as a public safety telecommunicator, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2012

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Community Affairs*

### **SB 532 (2R) by Senator Altman and others—**

**College Credit for Military Training and Education Courses;** Requiring the Board of Governors of the State University System and the State Board of Education to adopt regulations and rules, respectively, which enable United States Armed Forces servicemembers to earn college credit for college-level training and education acquired in the military, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2012

*Reported favorably by the Committees on Military Affairs, Space, and Domestic Security; Higher Education; Budget Subcommittee on Higher Education Appropriations; and Budget*

### **SB 534 (2R) by Senator Sobel—**

**Persons Excused from Jury Service;** Expanding parental eligibility to be excused from jury service; authorizing a presiding judge to excuse a practicing psychologist from jury service, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2012

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Judiciary*

**CS/SB 578 (2R) by the Committee on Budget Subcommittee on General Government Appropriations and Senator Richter—**

**Depopulation Programs of Citizens Property Insurance Corporation;** Providing that eligible surplus lines insurers may participate, in the same manner and on the same terms as an authorized insurer, in depopulation, take-out, or keep-out programs relating to policies removed from Citizens Property Insurance Corporation; authorizing information from underwriting files and confidential files to be released by the corporation to specified entities that are considering writing or underwriting risks insured by the corporation under certain circumstances; specifying that only the corporation's transfer of a policy file to an insurer, as opposed to the transfer of any file, changes the file's public record status, etc. Effective Date: upon becoming a law

*Reported favorably, with seven amendments, by the Committee on Banking and Insurance; reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Budget Subcommittee on General Government Appropriations; and withdrawn from the Committee on Budget*

**CS/CS/CS/SB 682 (2R) by the Committees on Budget Subcommittee on Health and Human Services Appropriations, Governmental Oversight and Accountability, Children, Families, and Elder Affairs, Senator Richter and others—**

**Alzheimer's Disease;** Establishing the Purple Ribbon Task Force within the Department of Elderly Affairs; providing that members shall serve without compensation or reimbursement for per diem or travel expenses; requiring the department to provide administrative support; authorizing the task force to hold meetings by teleconference or other electronic means, or in person without compensation or reimbursement for per diem or travel expenses; requiring the task force to submit a report in the form of an Alzheimer's disease state plan to the Governor and Legislature, etc. Effective Date: upon becoming a law

**CS/CS/CS/SB 694 (2R) by the Committees on Budget Subcommittee on Health and Human Services Appropriations, Health Regulation, Children, Families, and Elder Affairs, Senator Fasano and others—**

**Adult Day Care Centers;** Citing this act as the "Josephine Corcoran Specialized Alzheimer's Services Adult Day Care Act"; prohibiting an adult day care center from claiming to be licensed or designated as a specialized Alzheimer's services adult day care center under certain circumstances; providing educational and experience requirements for the operator of an adult day care center seeking licensure designation as a specialized Alzheimer's services adult day care center; requiring that dementia-specific services be documented in a participant's file; requiring that the center coordinate and execute discharge procedures with a participant who has a documented diagnosis of Alzheimer's disease or a dementia-related disorder and the caregiver if the participant's enrollment in the center is involuntarily terminated, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2012

**OGSR/Donor Information/House Museums Designated as National Historic Landmarks;** Amending provisions relating to an exemption from public records requirements provided for information that identifies a donor or prospective donor to publicly owned house museums designated by the United States Department of Interior as National Historic Landmarks who desires to remain anonymous; saving the exemption from repeal under the Open Government Sunset Review Act; removing the scheduled repeal of the exemption, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2012

*Reported favorably by the Committees on Environmental Preservation and Conservation; and Governmental Oversight and Accountability*

**CS/SB 830 (2R) by the Committees on Governmental Oversight and Accountability, and Health Regulation—**

**OGSR/Physician Workforce Surveys/Department of Health;** Amending provisions relating to exemptions from public records requirements for personal identifying information contained in physician workforce surveys submitted to the Department of Health by physicians and osteopathic physicians; saving the exemptions from repeal under the Open Government Sunset Review Act; removing the scheduled repeal of each exemption, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2012

**CS/SB 832 (2R) by the Committees on Governmental Oversight and Accountability, and Higher Education—**

**OGSR/Donor Information Direct-support Organization/University of Florida/Historic Preservation of the City of St. Augustine;** Amending provisions which provide an exemption from public records requirements for information identifying a donor or prospective donor to the direct-support organization established by the University of Florida in the historic preservation of the City of St. Augustine; saving the exemption from repeal under the Open Government Sunset Review Act; removing the scheduled repeal of the exemption, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2012

**CS/SB 844 (2R) by the Committees on Governmental Oversight and Accountability, and Communications, Energy, and Public Utilities—**

**OGSR/Sunshine State One-Call of Florida, Inc.;** Amending provisions relating to an exemption from public records requirements for proprietary confidential business information held by Sunshine State One-Call of Florida, Inc.; saving the exemption from repeal under the Open Government Sunset Review Act; deleting the scheduled repeal of the exemption, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2012

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Communications, Energy, and Public Utilities; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability*

**CS/SB 954 (2R) by the Committee on Transportation and Senator Margolis—**

**Transportation Facility Designations;** Providing honorary designations of certain transportation facilities in specified counties; directing the Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2012

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Transportation*

**SB 988 (2R) by Senator Joyner—**

**Probate;** Excluding real property owned in tenancy by the entireties or in joint tenancy with rights of survivorship from the definition of the term “protected homestead”; clarifying the application of amendments to s. 732.102, F.S., made by chapter 2011-183, Laws of Florida, relating to a spouse’s share of an intestate estate; revising the period of time during which an attorney in fact or guardian of the property of a surviving spouse may petition for approval to elect to take a one-half interest in the decedent’s homestead; specifying the minimum duration of an extension of time; barring inheritance rights of a natural or adoptive parent whose parental rights have been previously terminated pursuant to law; providing for application of the act, etc. Effective Date: upon becoming a law, except as otherwise provided

**Elections;** Removing a provision prohibiting the use of the address appearing on the identification presented by an elector as a basis for confirming the elector’s legal residence; requiring that tickets and advertising for campaign fund raisers comply with the requirements for political advertisements; revising the information that is required to appear on a bank account for the deposit of funds received by a campaign treasurer for a candidate or political committee; revising the information that is required to appear on bank account checks of candidates or political committees; revising the information that is used to determine whether debit cards are considered bank checks, etc. Effective Date: upon becoming a law

**CS/SB's 1776, 456, 766 & 926 (2R) by the Committee on Transportation, Senators Evers, Negron, Oelrich and Altman—**

**Transportation Facility Designations;** (THIS BILL COMBINES S1776, S456, S766, & S926) Providing honorary designations of certain transportation facilities in specified counties; directing the Department of Transportation to erect suitable markers, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2012

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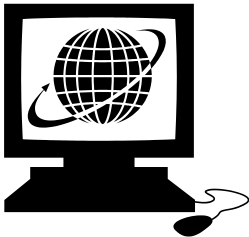
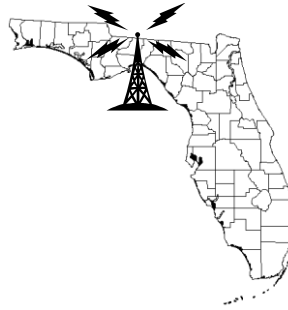




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
