**Infant Death;** Revising the education and orientation requirements for birth centers and their families to incorporate safe sleep practices and causes of Sudden Unexpected Infant Death; revising legislative findings and intent with respect to the sudden unexpected death of an infant under a specified age; defining the term “Sudden Unexpected Infant Death”; revising provisions relating to training requirements for first responders; revising requirements relating to autopsies performed by medical examiners, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2013

### SB 244 (2R) by Senator Dean—

**Water Management Districts;** Providing for the adoption of certain reservations and minimum flows and levels by the Department of Environmental Protection; requiring water management districts to apply, without adopting by rule, the reservations, minimum flows and levels, and recovery and prevention strategies adopted by the department; requiring a regional water supply authority and the applicable water management district to jointly develop the water supply component of the regional water supply plan, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2013

### CS/SB 298 (2R) by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability and Senator Brandes—

**Department of Citrus;** Reverting certain references to the Department of Citrus that were changed to references to the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services by chapter 2012-182, Laws of Florida; providing for retroactive application; requiring the repeal of certain rules adopted by the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law.
