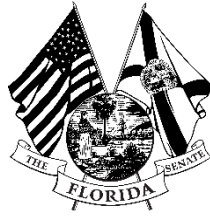

## BILLS ON THIRD READING

### **CS/SB 352 (3R) by the Committee on Ethics and Elections and Senator Hutson—**

**Legislative Redistricting and Congressional Reapportionment;** Providing that candidate qualifying, nomination, and election for certain offices must proceed using current district boundaries if revisions to districts subject to a court challenge are not made as of a certain date; specifying public oversight procedures that a court is encouraged to follow when drafting a remedial redistricting plan, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

### **SB 7004 (3R) by the Committee on Health Policy (Young)—**

**OGSR/Peer Review Panels/Department of Health;** Amending provisions relating to exemptions from public records and public meetings requirements for specified portions of meetings of certain peer review panels appointed by the Department of Health, for specified records generated by such peer review panels, and for research grant applications provided to such peer review panels; removing the scheduled repeal of the exemptions, etc. Effective Date: 10/01/2017

## SENATE BILLS ON SECOND READING

### **CS/SB 8 (2R) by the Committee on Appropriations and Senator Galvano—**

**Gaming;** Authorizing the Department of the Lottery to create a program that authorizes certain persons to purchase a ticket at a point-of-sale terminal; ratifying and approving a specified compact executed by the Governor and the Seminole Tribe of Florida contingent upon the adoption of specified amendments to the compact; specifying the amendments that must be made to the compact by agreement between the Governor and the Tribe for the compact to be deemed ratified and approved; creating the "Fantasy Contest Amusement Act", etc. Effective Date: Contingent

*Reported favorably by the Committee on Regulated Industries; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Appropriations*

### **CS/CS/SB 106 (2R) by the Committees on Rules, Regulated Industries and Senator Flores—**

**Vendors Licensed Under the Beverage Law;** Revising applicability to specify circumstances under which persons under the age of 18 years who are employed in specified businesses are excluded from certain employment prohibitions; providing that failure to comply with a restriction on monthly revenue from the sale of alcoholic beverages is unlawful if a minor is employed during a month that the restriction is exceeded; limiting the package store restrictions to vendors located within a certain distance of a school, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2017

*Reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Regulated Industries; and reported favorably as a committee substitute by the Committee on Rules*

### **SB 436 (2R) by Senator Baxley and others—**

**Religious Expression in Public Schools;** Citing this act as the "Florida Student and School Personnel Religious Liberties Act"; Prohibiting a school district from discriminating against students, parents, or school personnel on the basis of religious viewpoints or expression; prohibiting penalty or reward for a student's religious expression in coursework, artwork, or other specified assignments; requiring a school district to comply with the federal requirements in Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2017
