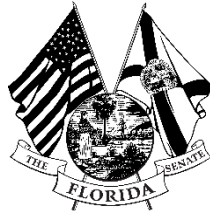

Public Records; Revising the circumstances under which a court must assess and award the reasonable costs of enforcement against an agency in a civil action to enforce ch. 119, F.S.; prohibiting the assessment and award of the reasonable costs of enforcement to a complainant who acted with an improper purpose, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

CS/SB 220 (3R) by the Committee on Regulated Industries, Senator Latvala and others—

Veterinary Medicine; Defining “complementary or alternative and integrative therapies,” “physical examination,” “veterinary dentistry,” and “veterinary telemedicine”; revising the definitions of “veterinarian/client/patient relationship,” and “veterinary medicine”, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2017

CS/SB 164 (SO) by the Committee on Transportation, Senator Grimsley and others—

Certificates of Title for Motor Vehicles; Prohibiting the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles and tax collector from charging any fee or service charge, except for the expedited title fee, if applicable, for a certificate of title issued for a motor vehicle solely to remove a deceased coowner from a title registered in the name of two persons if the other coowner is the surviving spouse, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2017

SB 174 (SO) by Senator Artiles—

Enterprise Information Technology Services Management Act; Revising certain powers, duties, and functions of the Agency for State Technology in collaboration with the Department of Management Services; authorizing certain service-level agreements entered into by the state data center to be extended for a specified duration, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2017

Reported favorably by the Committee on Governmental Oversight and Accountability; and reported favorably by the Committee on Appropriations

SB 358 (SO) by Senator Garcia—

Mental Health and Substance Abuse; Authorizing the Department of Children and Families to approve receiving systems for behavioral health care; deleting an obsolete provision requiring a report by the department and the Agency for Health Care Administration; requiring the department to post certain data on its website; specifying that certain court hearings must be scheduled within 5 court working days unless a continuance is granted, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2017

Reported favorably by the Committee on Children, Families, and Elder Affairs; recommended favorably by Appropriations Subcommittee on Health and Human Services; and reported favorably by the Committee on Appropriations

CS/SB 8 (SO) by the Committee on Appropriations and Senator Galvano—

Gaming; Authorizing the Department of the Lottery to create a program that authorizes certain persons to purchase a ticket at a point-of-sale terminal; ratifying and approving a specified compact executed by the Governor and the Seminole Tribe of Florida contingent upon the adoption of specified amendments to the compact; specifying the amendments that must be made to the compact by agreement between the Governor and the Tribe for the compact to be deemed ratified and approved; creating the “Fantasy Contest Amusement Act”, etc. Effective Date: Contingent

Criminal History Records; Prohibiting a person or entity engaged in publishing or disseminating arrest booking photographs from soliciting or accepting a fee or other payment to remove a photograph; authorizing a person whose arrest booking photograph is published to request in writing that it be removed; revising the elements that must be attested to by a petitioner in a statement submitted in support of the expunction of criminal history records, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2017

SB 78 (SO) by Senator Flores and others—

Public School Recess; Requiring each district school board to provide students in certain grades with a minimum number of minutes of free-play recess per week and with a minimum number of consecutive minutes of free-play recess per day, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2017

**SENATE BILLS ON

SB 350 (2R) by Senator Clemens—

Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission; Requiring the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission to implement, administer, maintain, and revise a basic abilities examination by a specified date; requiring that examination fees be deposited in the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Trust Fund; reenacting provisions relating to examinations, administration, and materials not being public records, to incorporate the amendment made to provisions in a reference thereto, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2017

Reported favorably by the Committee on Criminal Justice; recommended favorably by Appropriations Subcommittee on Criminal and Civil Justice; and reported favorably by the Committee on Appropriations

SB 1048 (2R) by Senator Lee—

Linear Facilities; Revising the definition of the term “development” to exclude work by certain utility providers on utility infrastructure on certain rights-of-way or corridors; requiring the consideration of a certain variance standard when including conditions for the certification of an electrical power plant; requiring the consideration of a certain variance standard when including conditions for the certification of a proposed transmission line corridor, etc. Effective Date: Upon becoming a law

Reported favorably by the Committee on Communications, Energy, and Public Utilities; and reported favorably by the Committee on Community Affairs

SB 7006 (2R) by the Committee on Health Policy (Young)—

Direct-support Organization of the Prescription Drug Monitoring Program; Abrogating the repeal of provisions authorizing the Department of Health to establish a direct-support organization for the prescription drug monitoring program, etc. Effective Date: 07/01/2017
