
(A) *Amend Section (3)(a) entitled "Consideration," including any subsequent amendments*

Replace Section (3)(a), including any subsequent amendments, with

In consideration for providing legal services to the Legislature and FDOE, the Legislature will pay the Firm \$415.00 per hour for services rendered by Firm attorneys who have developed an expertise in litigation involving school adequacy and financing issues, and \$175.00 per hour for paralegal assistance. The Legislature, FDOE, and the Firm acknowledge that this rate reflects a reduction from the rates normally charged by the Firm for legal services. For legal services provided from December 1, 2014 through the trial court proceedings in *Citizens for Strong Schools v Florida Board of Education*, the total amount paid by the Legislature to the Firm will not exceed \$2,900,000.00, including authorized expenses that are incurred or paid by the Firm after December 1, 2014.

This amendment is effective December 1, 2014. All other provisions of the agreement remain unchanged and in full effect.



(A) Amend Section (3)(a) entitled "Consideration"

Replace Section (3)(a) with:

In consideration for providing legal services to the Legislature and FDOE, the Legislature will pay the Firm \$415.00 per hour for services rendered by Firm attorneys who have developed an expertise in litigation involving school adequacy and financing issue, and \$175.00 per hour for paralegal assistance. The Legislature, FDOE, and the Firm acknowledge that this rate reflects a reduction from the rates normally charged by the Firm for legal services. For legal services provided from June 1, 2016, through the completion of all appellate court proceedings in Citizens for Strong Schools v Florida Board of Education (including any appeal proceeding before the Supreme Court of Florida, if necessary), the total amount paid by the Legislature to the Firm will not exceed \$375,000.

This amendment is effective June 1, 2016. All other provisions of the agreement remain unchanged and in full effect.






