Issue	Offer
Seminole Compact	Retain the Senate position, <u>except</u> provide that if the Seminole Tribe asserts a violation of the exclusivity granted to the Tribe under the Compact, as amended, then the Legislature will have 24 months after receipt of the notice of the violation or the end of the second Regular Session after receipt of the notice, whichever is later, to pass legislation to remedy the alleged violation of exclusivity, before any consequences to revenue sharing.
Pari-mutuel Wagering	Retain the Senate position.
Slot Machines	Retain the Senate position <u>and also</u> : 1) Revise the definition of a "slot machine or device" in s. 849.16, FS, to include any machine or device which: a) Includes a preview of the outcome of any game or a feature where the outcome of any game is known, displayed, or capable of display to the user; b) Offers the opportunity to purchase a subsequently displayed outcome equal to, greater than, or less than the cost to purchase that outcome; or c) Is defined as a type of Class III gaming under the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act. 2) Allow both of the two new, non-referendum slot machine facilities to be located in the same county (in either Broward or Miami-Dade Counties).
Blackjack	Retain the Senate position.
Cardrooms	Retain the Senate position.
Point-of-Sale Lottery Tickets	Retain the Senate position.
Fantasy Contests	Retain the Senate position.
Bingo	Retain the Senate position <u>and also</u> authorize park and recreational districts created as independent special districts and recreational districts, to conduct bingo and instant bingo at locations permitted under chapter 849, FS, and on district property.
Effective Date	Retain the Senate position.
