4. Project/Program Description

For nearly half a century, Crosswinds has been a safety net for young people and their families in crisis. Our programs work to break and prevent the tragic cycles of homelessness, abuse, neglect, substance abuse, delinquency and other negative outcomes by providing immediate interventions for young people and by strengthening youth and families. Crosswinds' cornerstone program, the Robert E. Lehton Children's Shelter, located on our campus in Cocoa, offers 24/7 emergency residential care for youth who have run away, are homeless, have had their foster home placement interrupted or are in respite. Funds requested are for a complete access control system featuring the Keri NXT/Series, NET control system to harden access to the Crosswinds' campus and emergency shelter. The project includes equipping the facility with a wireless integrated door and shelter window alarm system. The software will provide a comprehensive management tool for fully controlling facility access.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

For several years the provider of Crosswinds' CCTV system has worked to improve campus safety. The system was upgraded in 2021. ids Technologies recommends the access control system as a significant improvement for the safety and security of the Crosswinds' campus especially the youth shelter.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Through our seven programs, Crosswinds works to break and prevent the tragic cycles of homelessness, abuse, neglect, substance abuse, delinquency and other negative outcomes by providing immediate interventions and counseling for young people and by strengthening children, youth and families. The goal is to keep families intact and help children and youth create opportunities for them to succeed.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Funding will allow for a more secure location for our services. Crosswinds provides emergency shelter for youth; transitional housing and skills training; assist and reunite families in crisis through counseling; help youth who have aged out of the foster care system; provide timely interventions for young offenders; help parents work with younger children who have troubling behavior; and more.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is ages 6 to 24 years old. Crosswinds projects serving over 800 youth and families on our campus annually.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Through surveys, 100% of program participants, staff and stakeholders will report the implementation of the access control system has increased their confidence in Crosswinds' campus security and safety.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?
