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The City will engage a vendor to construct a new 911 Communications Tower that will service the Hialeah Heights Annexation area.

The new 911 Communications Tower will improve communications between first responders at the scene of an emergency and dispatch, thus improving the service to the public and eliminating any lapses in communication during critical situations requiring rapid response.
