4.	Project/Program D	escription					
	Sundberg Road is a publicly maintained dirt road connecting CR 121 [formerly State Road 121] and Andrews Road [a Major Collector roadway]. Sundberg directly serves established rural home sites as well as provides an alternative to US Hwy 1 northwest of the Town of Hilliard in Nassau County. The County has identified Sundberg as a transportation facility necessary to support the long term health of Nassau County's overall transportation network. The adopted Mobility Plan identified the importance of Sundberg Road in the overall transportation network. The County's Capital Improvement Plan adopted in June 2022 allocated \$881,374 towards construction. The request of \$750,000 represents a 54% cost share/match with the State. The Legislature will be leveraging \$1.17 for every \$1 in funding.
