#### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of Let's Talk is to provide free, confidential, behavioral health navigation and support to individuals in need throughout a multi-county region of Pinellas, Hillsborough, Pasco, and Polk counties; including navigation to local providers, brief counseling, peer supports, self-directed resources, and immediate connection to crisis supports where necessary. Addressing behavioral health challenges before they intensify will lead to long-term improvements in population health and quality of life. N/A is not considered a valid response.



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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds will support 5,000 calls per year to the Let's Talk line facilitating Tampa Bay area residents to behavioral health care supports and will provide promotion of the service to residents

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Let's Talk will connect Tampa Bay area callers who are experiencing a mental health challenge with local trained counselors who will establish rapport with the caller, conduct a screening to determine caller type and identify any risk factors, provide support to the individual in need through collaborative problem solving, and connect the caller to local supports and services near them.

Pinellas, Hillsborough, Polk and Pasco County residents.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Addressing mental health challenges before they escalate to acute or crisis levels.

Short-term: measuring the number of calls to Let's Talk, primary presenting need, whether or not the individual accessed care, and satisfaction. Long-term: reducing the percentage of people reporting poor mental health days; reducing the use of the ER for mental health concerns; reduction in suicides and overdoses.
