a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Phase I Construction

To provide for the first phase of construction for sanitary sewer service to eighty six (86) properties in the City's Original Section along Swain Boulevard from Lake Worth Road northwards to approximately 300 feet south of 10th Avenue North.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction of the first phase of a sewer system in the City's Original Section. Palm Beach County Water Utility District will maintain the system and it can be expanded to include the entire community longterm.



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c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Sanitary sewer service to eighty six (86) homes along Swain Boulevard in the City's Original Section. Reduction of pollutants into the groundwater system through collection of waste water through a sewer system.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population are the 300+ residents who reside along Swain Boulevard

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

All homes will be required to connect to the sewer system. Removal of 85 gallons of wastewater produced per capita per day for the 86 properties from the groundwater and storm water system. Reduction of pollution into groundwater by sewer system collection of wastewater. Reduction of pollutants leading into the LWDD Canal E-3, LWDD Canal L-11, and LWDD Canal L-10.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

If the City fails to meet deliverables or performance measures, a penalty requiring reimbursement of appropriated funds received should be imposed.
