a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Distribution of bloodhounds to law enforcement agencies and police departments, tracking and trailing seminars for bloodhounds and K9 officers and training programs to include travel expenses, bloodhound care and upkeep and maintenance, community outreach initiatives and programs including but not limited to attendance at law enforcement conferences, marketing including education/awareness.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Jimmy Ryce was abducted, raped & murdered in 1995, getting off of his school bus in Redland, Florida. For 3 months his parents, Don and Claudine, led an extensive search. The Ryces always believed that if a bloodhound was available when Jimmy was abducted he would have been found, alive. The Jimmy Ryce Center was established and our mission is to provide bloodhounds to law enforcement agencies.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

To honor their son's memory, they established the Jimmy Ryce Center for Victims of Predatory Abduction. To date, the Jimmy Ryce Center has donated nearly 700 bloodhounds to law enforcement agencies. Our mission is to make the Ryce's goal a reality. Our efforts will help law enforcement search to find missing children, as well as endangered adults.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The bloodhounds will be utilized to assist law enforcement agencies to find missing children and endangered adults. The FBI and National Center for Missing and Exploited Children are all proponents of bloodhounds and their abilities. The National Center even named a training center after Jimmy Ryce
