14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Goal is to purchase and install 15 back-up generators to harden critical assets of 15 lift station facilities. The severe flooding received from Hurricane Ian, the severe rise of the Peace River and the seepage of sewerage overflow accompanied by an extended widespread power outage has dictated the essential need for all lift stations to be fully operational to prevent wastewater effluent from infiltrating surface/ground waters and entering dwellings creating a health hazard.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

To seek contractual services to purchase and install 15 emergency generators to wastewater lift stations through the City's procurement process.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Operational wastewater lift stations protect the citizens from effluent backing up into homes, dwellings, businesses and infiltrating into ground and surface waters; protecting life and health of the community. Severe flooding occurred from Hurricane Ian, the severe rise of the Peace River and the seepage of sewerage overflow accompanied by an extended widespread power outage has dictated the critical need for generators on all lift stations.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is the City of Bartow which serves as the County seat for Regional, Federal and State offices, agencies, properties and buildings, which are tax exempt creating a reduction of revenue that is needed to adequately serve its citizenry; and surrounding communities - Clear Springs Developments, the City of Eagle lake, and the Polk State College Advanced Technology Center Campus. More than 19,477 individuals to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Benefit is fully operational wastewater lift stations during power outages, flooding and severe storms events as sewage is properly disposed to the wastewater regional treatment plant; improved groundwater, surface water quality. Completed installation and operation of 15 emergency generators provides for resiliency, efficient, consistent and reliable wastewater management of critical assets. Certification of project.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Non-payment of invoices until milestones achieved; implementation of corrective action plan.
