4. Project/Program Description

Hurricane lan delivered 15-20 inches of rainfall within a 36-hour period in the city of Kissimmee while balancing waters received from jurisdictions to the north. It has been documented that the effects of this storm are one of the worst in Kissimmee history. With more than 700 homes experiencing major damage and thousands more at risk, the impacts of Hurricane Ian continue to consume the fears of our community regarding what the City will do to mitigate the devastating flood effects in the future. In light of the recent flood events, the city desires to fast track the completion of the Stormwater Master Plan that began in phases in 2020. Upon completion of the plan, the City will have a detailed and accurate assessment of the existing systems, have an ability to prioritize stormwater needs for the basin, and develop a comprehensive plan to finance the construction, operation and maintenance of critical stormwater collection systems.
