a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of the project is to reduce water service interruption due to pipe breaks by replacing and upsizing water line. Improved fire protection will be provided with the installation of new fire hydrants

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



Repayment of state funds.

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Engineering, permitting, surveying and construction services to replace approximately 8,250 linear feet of existing 10-inch and 6-inch potable water mains located within the Pine Lakes Estates neighborhood with minimum 8-inch diameter pipe and fire hydrants.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The citizens will see an increase in potable water service and fire protection capabilities with fewer water service interruptions and less disruption in the community from emergency repairs of water line breaks.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project will directly benefit the 159 residences in the Pine Lake Estates neighborhood consisting of approximately 400 people.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The project will provide increased fire protection with new fire hydrants and improved water pressure as measured by fire hydrant flow testing documenting the water flow available for fire protection.

The project will result in a significant reduction in interruption of potable water service to the community due to water line breaks reducing the potential for contamination. The outcome will be measured by the number of service interruptions per year as measured by work orders to repair broken water pipes and restore service.
