a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Extend natural gas lines to the rural towns of Laurel Hill and Paxton located in North Okaloosa and Walton Counties in Florida.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Engineering, Design and Installation of Natural Gas Pipeline to the described area adjacent to Highway 85 North to Laurel Hill then East to Paxton. All lines will serve all homes, businesses and first responders in these areas.



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c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Availability of Natural Gas Service to all home owners that will provide them a less expensive and more reliable energy option than electricity and propane.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All homeowners, business owners and emergency responders along the intended and adjacent path of the natural gas main extension. This will include the current populated areas and future growth of the market area.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected Benefit to the project allows for the opportunity to serve natural gas to a rural area of the Northwest Florida Community. Natural Gas will provide a less expensive and more reliable energy source for the citizens and surrounding areas of Laurel Hill and Paxton to include natural gas in times of emergency for home generation and a more effective heating source during the winter.
