b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Design and construction of a central sanitary sewer system to eliminate 930 failing septic tanks to reduce nutrients from stormwater runoff thereby reducing the production of red tide and blue green algae in Naples Bay.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Design and construction of a central sanitary sewer system, thereby eliminating septic tanks, will protect the general public (residents in this area specifically) from the significant health risks associated with septic tanks.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The 930 residential properties within the US 41/Goodlette Road corridor located within unincorporated Collier County but within the City of Naples water and sewer service area.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Reduction of nutrients in the water quality of the stormwater runoff to Naples Bay. Water quality samples will be collected before and after construction of the sanitary sewer system.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

All contracts have performance requirements and penalties that protect the state's and the public's investment. No additional penalties are needed for this project.
