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Provide an updated gym for sporting events and community events for the community of Cottondale and for the 1000 students and families of the community.

Improved community engagement within the school community in a safe and modern structure.

Pre school students, grade school students, high school students, university and college students, at-risk youth, economically-disadvantaged persons, developmentally disabled, physically disabled, elderly persons. Approximately 1000 students and their families.

Improved quality of education due to a modern, safe structure for physical education as measured by student performance on physical education and health standards. The project will create an estimated 36 full-time equivalent jobs with an overall economic impact of \$1.5 million to the local economy during construction.
