#### 14. Program Performance



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a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of the requested funds is to demolish the current maintenance complex and construct a new maintenance complex off-campus in order to provide more room in a central location on campus for academic buildings.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds will be used to demolish and relocate the 45-year-old maintenance complex located in the heart of FSU's campus. Furthermore, funds will be used for site preparation, to remove the old motor pool facility and fuel station, and upgrade infrastructure and utilities. This central location on campus would be more efficiently and effectively utilized for core academics, research, and student services.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Relocation of FSU's campus facilities complex will allow FSU to more efficiently and effectively utilize the land for core academic research and student services.,

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is FSU's approximately 45,000 university students.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will improve the quality of education at FSU by making available a significant portion of land in the heart of campus to be put to better use for core academics, research, and student services. The maintenance facility houses hazardous materials (fuel tanks), so the facility is fenced in. This means that students have to detour around the compound. This issue is exacerbated by the facility's position in the heart of campus. Better utilizing this land and integrating it into its surroundings will improve the quality of life on campus.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Revert state appropriation and withhold future funding for this initiative.
