14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The Barn at Leland Young Legacy Park will be utilized as a Polk County mixed use recreation, cultural arts venue and government facility, with restrooms, parking, kitchens, office space and equipment storage housed on the property's 13 acres. The location in Alturas, FL, would also serve as the trail head for a Scenic Central Florida Cycling route and has potential for a concert venue and experiential agricultural education opportunities. Events of all sizes will be and have been, accommodated inside The Barn and the surrounding grounds. The funding of this project would allow The Barn's history and the multi-generational generosity of Leland Young to Polk County and the State of Florida to continue. As urbanization and agricultural hardship, threaten the ability of the continued use of this iconic Barn, this funding and the legacy of almost 100 years of selfless generosity will be secured for future generations of the State of Florida to enjoy.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

As stated in the purpose and goal, The Barn at Leland Young Legacy Park will be utilized as a Polk County mixed use recreation, cultural arts venue and government facility, with restrooms, parking, kitchens, office space and equipment storage. The Barn will serve as the trail head for a Scenic Central Florida Cycling route and has potential for a concert venue and experiential agricultural education opportunities. Events of all sizes will be and have been, accommodated inside The Barn and the surrounding grounds may be used as camp grounds, RV and picnic facilities.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services at The Barn at Leland Young Legacy Park will include, but not be limited to, a venue for private events with facilities being able to accommodate intimate groups up to large scale events of thousands. The nature of these events will range from professional to athletic to philanthropic to educational to government. The Barn is equipped with kitchens, offices, restrooms and ample square footage for adaptable event layouts. The surrounding grounds will be utilized for a launching point to the area's cycling opportunities, with the potential to house camp grounds, RV and picnic facilities.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Continuing the use of The Barn as Leland Young has selflessly provided in the past, events have targeted the general citizenry, civic groups, athletes, agriculture, students and government. Attendees on an annual basis could conservatively exceed 40,000 persons.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Presently, the Polk County Board of County Commissioners has identified the Alturas area as under served in recreational, park and civic services and facilites. The Barn at Leland Young Legacy Park would begin to meet the mixed use recreational and cultural arts venue and facility needs as identified by Polk County. Attendance, community satisfaction, event/facility rental revenues and Polk County Sports Marketing economic analysis are methodologies by which outcomes may be measured.
