


GOVERNOR RICK SCOTT Fiscal Year 2012-2013








Unemployment Rates By State

 - Executive Order Examining Special Districts




2. Phase Out Florida's Business Tax

- Eliminates the tax for another 27% of businesses




Doubling the Corporate Income Tax Exemption form \$25,000 to \$50,000





Personal Property Tax – Exempt all Taxpayers with less than \$50k in property






Sales Tax – Machinery and Equipment
