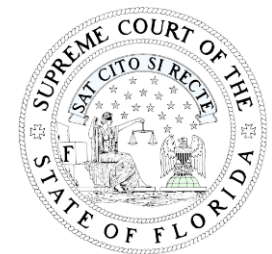

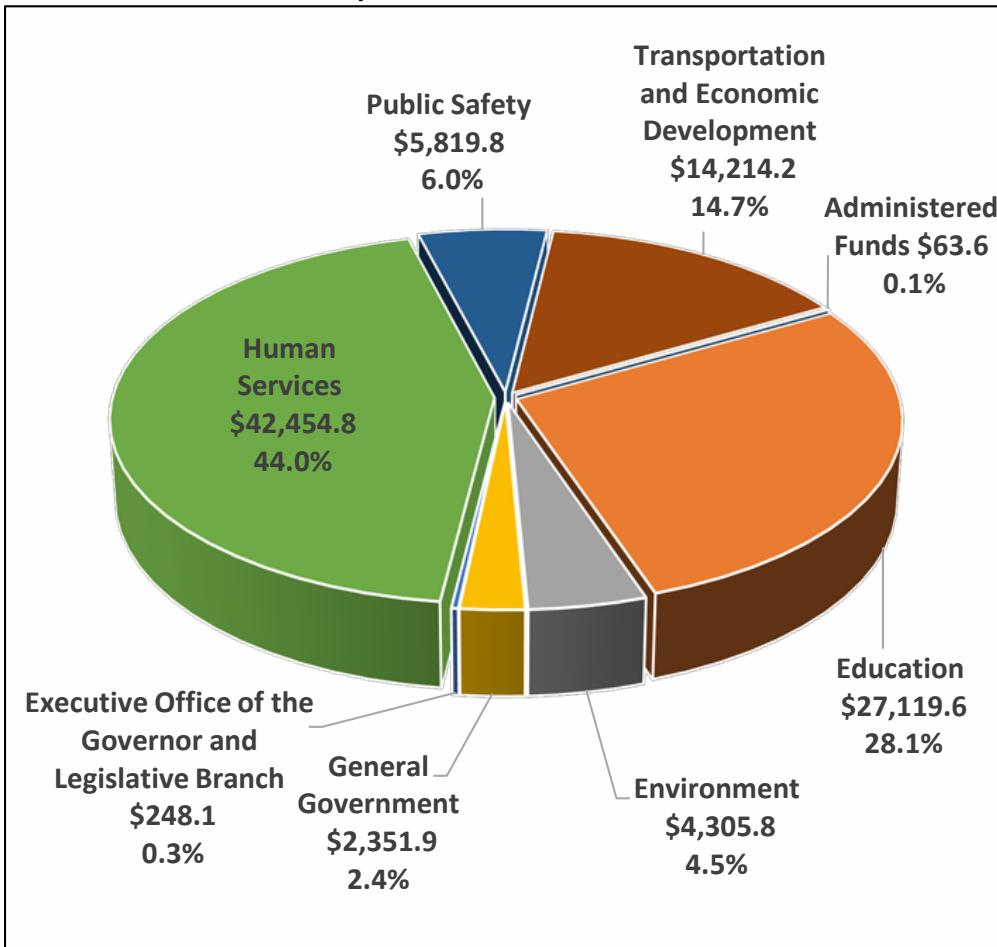

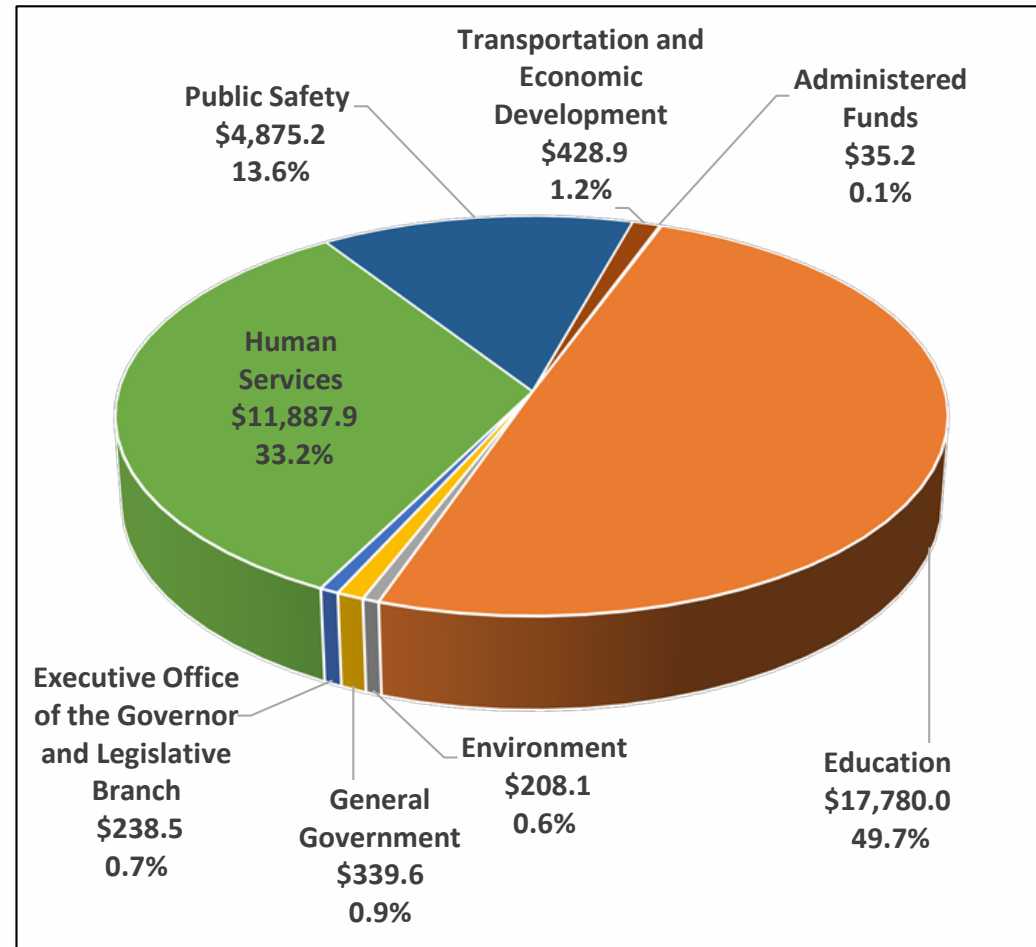


Florida Leads Budget

\$96.6 Billion



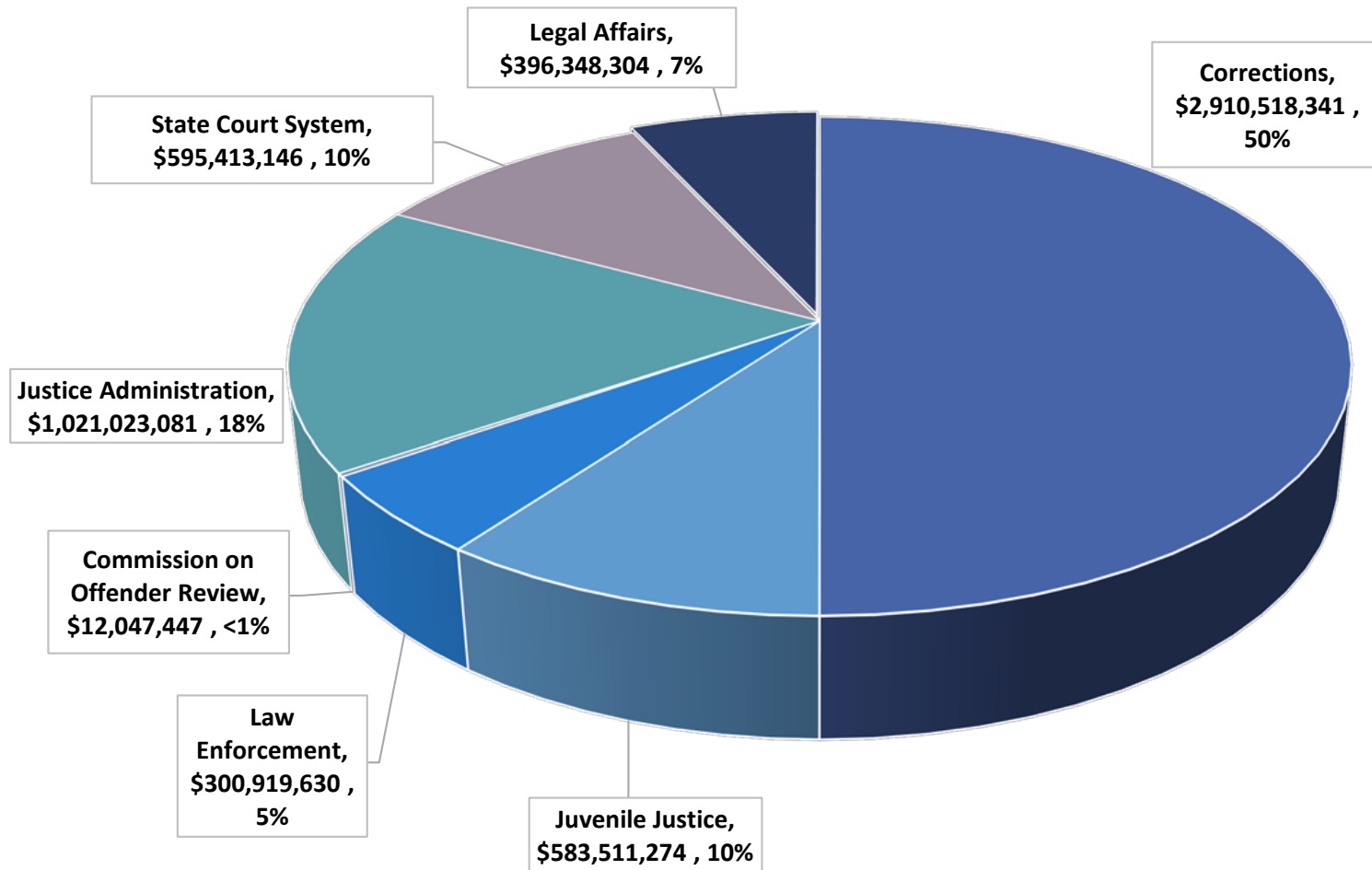
General Revenue
