Online Registration Process for Transient Students: Update

January 24, 2012

Online Registration Assignment

- S. 1004.091 (2)(b) directs the Florida Distance Learning Consortium to implement a streamlined online registration process for undergraduate **transient** students.
- The Consortium is directed to "work with the Florida College System and the State University System to implement this admissions application process."

Increased Access

- > Increase in online courses: From 6,000 courses listed in 2005 to **28,272** in 2010-11.
- Variety of online programs: Distance Learning Catalog contains 613 program listings from certificate to PhD programs.
- ➤ Heavy usage of transient student admissions system: FACTS processed over 44,000 students last year through its transient student admissions system.

Online Degree Availability


- Florida public colleges and universities now offer **642** online degree programs.
- During 2012, 69 additional online degree programs will become available.
- ➤ Of the **711** total online academic programs that will be available by the end of 2012:
 - 321 are offered at 26 colleges
 - 390 are offered at 10 universities

Implementation Approach

- Added content, registration buttons and course availability indicators to the distance learning catalog.
- Adapted the existing transient admissions process within FACTS
- ➤ Add financial aid officers to the process and include financial aid procedures and reporting for transient students
- Automate the reporting of transient student credit/grades utilizing the Florida Automated Student Transcript Education Reporting (FASTER) system.

Next Steps

- Complete the implementation of financial aid procedures.
- ➤ Complete the implementation of the electronic transfer of credit awarded by the institutions offering the course to the transient student's home institution.
