4	<b>SB 1718</b> Book (Identical H 1279)	Cosmetic Animal Testing; Citing this act as the "Humane Cosmetics Act"; prohibiting a manufacturer from manufacturing, importing for profit, selling, or offering for sale a cosmetic developed or manufactured using cosmetic animal testing conducted or contracted by certain persons or from conducting or contracting for cosmetic animal testing; providing exceptions; providing labeling requirements for specified cosmetics; providing enforcement and civil penalties, etc. CM 01/24/2022 Fav/CS AP RC	Fav/CS Yeas 9 Nays 0
