10	SB 1470 Hutson (Similar H 1077, Compare H 763, S 950)	Clerks of the Circuit Court; Requiring that a specified percentage of amounts recovered by the state attorney be remitted to the Department of Revenue to be deposited into the Grants and Donations Trust Fund of the applicable state attorney; requiring that specified appointed counsels be paid from funds appropriated to the Justice Administrative Commission; requiring the Florida Clerks of Court Operations Corporation to annually prepare a budget request to fund increases in employer contributions to the Florida Retirement System, etc. JU 01/29/2024 Fav/CS ACJ AP	Fav/CS Yeas 9 Nays 0
