Patt Maney Veterans' Treatment Intervention Act"; providing that a person who alleges that he or she committed a criminal offense as a result of posttraumatic stress disorder, traumatic brain injury, substance use disorder, or psychological problems stemming from service in a combat theater in the United States military may have a hearing on that issue before sentencing; creating a misdemeanor pretrial veterans' treatment intervention program; requiring that any veteran who meets specified criteria be admitted to any Florida College System institution or state university of the veteran's choice, etc.  MS 01/09/2012 Fav/CS CJ HE BC	Fav/CS Yeas 9 Nays 0
