Electric Vehicle Master Plan Florida Public Service Commission (FPSC) Tasks

- 20-year projection of EV use, how to ensure adequate supply of EV charging infrastructure, and evaluation of current and future technology
- Strategies to develop supply of charging stations
- Identify the regulatory structure necessary for delivery of electricity to EV charging station infrastructure, including competitively neutral policies and public utility participation in the marketplace



Florida Public Electric Utilities

- Vertically Integrated
 - o Generation, Transmission, Distribution of electricity to retail customers
- Exclusive Service Territories
- Regulatory Oversight by FPSC • Chapters 350 and 366, F.S.



FPSC Regulatory Authority

- Rate Base/Economic Regulation
 - Establish revenue requirements and set rates
 - Conduct earnings surveillance to ensure regulated utilities are not exceeding authorized rates of return
 - Municipal and Rural Cooperative utilities are exempt from FPSC rate setting authority
- Consumer Protection and Safety
 - Investigate consumer complaints
 - Conduct safety inspections of electric facilities
- Bulk Power Grid Planning
 - Oversight of the planning, development, and maintenance of the grid to ensure an adequate and reliable supply of energy



Electric Vehicle Charging

- Section 366.02(1), F.S., defines a public utility as any person, corporation, or other entity supplying electricity to or for the public within the state
 - Interpreted to mean that selling electricity to retail customers deems one a public utility subject to the rate setting authority of the FPSC
- Section 366.94(4), F.S., states that the provision of electric vehicle charging to the public by a non-utility is not the retail sale of electricity and not subject to regulation by the FPSC
 - $_{\odot}~$ EV charging stations are regulated by FDACS



EVMP Stakeholder Engagement

- Consensus that Florida's current regulatory structure is appropriate for delivery of electricity to EV charging stations
- Focus on flexibility to adopt different models of utility and third-party ownership
- Avoid prematurely and narrowly defining the role of public utilities



Utility Regulatory Considerations

- Utility interaction with third-party EV charging station owners
- Utility participation directly in the EV charging Marketplace



Utility and Third-Party EV Chargers

- Make-ready Installations
- Rates and Rate Design
 - Demand Charges
 - Time-of-use rates



Utility Participation

- Competitive Neutrality
- Cost of Service
 - Cost-based Rates
 - \circ Subsidization



Public Utility Programs

- EV Charging Pilot programs
- Mix of residential and commercial elements
- Rebates for EV charging station installation
- Rates for utility-owned and non-utility charging stations
