




SUN TRAIL POLICY FRAMEWORK



POLICY FRAMEWORK

- Program established in 2015
- Network aligns to DEP Florida Greenways and Trails System Plan's Land Trail Priority Network
- In 2023, the Network expanded to include connections to and through lands identified by the Florida Wildlife Corridor Act



SECTION 339.81, F.S., AND SB 106

".. the provision of paved multiuse trails within or between areas of the Florida Wildlife Corridor would provide the public the ability to enjoy Florida's natural resources and bring ecotourism and economic opportunities local trail town communities." – SB 106



SIGNAGE



"shall create uniform signage to identify trails that are part of the statewide network, and shall, when feasible and permissible erect signage on all such trails open to the public use..." – SB 106








Work Program:

SUN Trail Funding Increase:

- Annual recurring SUN Trail allocation increased from \$25 million to \$50 million
- Nonrecurring, \$200 million from General Revenue



SUN TRAIL PROGRAMMED FUNDS


