Outline of FHSAA Documents Senate Education Pre-K – 12 Committee October 7, 2015

By-Laws & Policy Changes since 2012

- All items in 2012 HB 1403 have been included
- Allowed non-member Florida or out of state schools to compete against FHSAA schools
- Transfers during school year are eligible at beginning of next sport season
- Comprehensive policies on education, prevention, treatment and return to play regarding concussions, heat acclimatization and sudden cardiac arrest
- Strengthened sanctions on coaches who violate major by-laws and/or policies
- Adopted mediation procedures for unresolved appeals through court certified mediators
- Permit all schools and student athletes option of participating in appeals by video conferencing

Proposed By-Laws for 2016

- Broaden representation on Board of Directors and Representative Assembly
- Expand provisions for eligibility regarding student transfers
- Provide options for public school students to participate at other schools if they attend nontraditional schools, special schools (vocational, magnet), or schools without full offering of sports

Understanding FHSAA's Budget

- Private corporation since 1920; designated non-profit since 1957; Legislative recognition 1997
- FHSAA does not receive state funding or tax dollars
- Rely on corporate support and State Series for 80% of funding 2% of funding is from fines; 3% is member dues/fees; remaining 15% is from Officials program, training fees and investments
- Member dues for HS are a flat \$25 per year and MS fees are \$10 per year
- 2015-16 budget has redirected \$1.1 million per year to member schools compared to 2008
- Major shift has taken place over seven years to rely on corporate and large events for funding and reduced reliance on member schools to pay fees. Member schools now provide 15% of funding instead of 35% in 2008.

FHSAA Appeals Process Update

- 2014-15 appeals process tracks the multiple levels of eligibility review
 - o Added new step of mediation court certified mediator
 - Board level appeals dropped from 79 per year to 11 appeals in 2014-15
