**Florida Kidcare: A Conversation with Senator Calatayud**

Do you have questions about Florida KidCare or wonder whether your family may qualify for affordable health coverage for your children? Florida KidCare provides low-cost health insurance options for children and serves as an important resource for working families who may earn too much to qualify for Medicaid but still struggle with the high cost of private health insurance.

In 2023, Senator Alexis Calatayud championed legislation to expand access to Florida KidCare by increasing the income eligibility threshold for subsidized coverage from 200% to 300% of the federal poverty level. Senator Calatayud continues to advocate to the state and federal government for approval of the program expansion for implementation, many families have questions about what these changes could mean for them, what coverage options are currently available, and how they can navigate the enrollment process.

To help answer those questions, I invite you to join us on June 13 at 10 am in Miami Dade College Kendall Campus- Building R- Room 254; for a community conversation about Florida KidCare. Whether you are currently enrolled, considering applying, or simply want to learn more, this event will provide an opportunity to hear directly from Florida KidCare experts, ask questions, share feedback, and discuss concerns in an open and welcoming environment. My goal is to ensure that every family in our community has the information and resources they need to make the best healthcare decisions for their children.

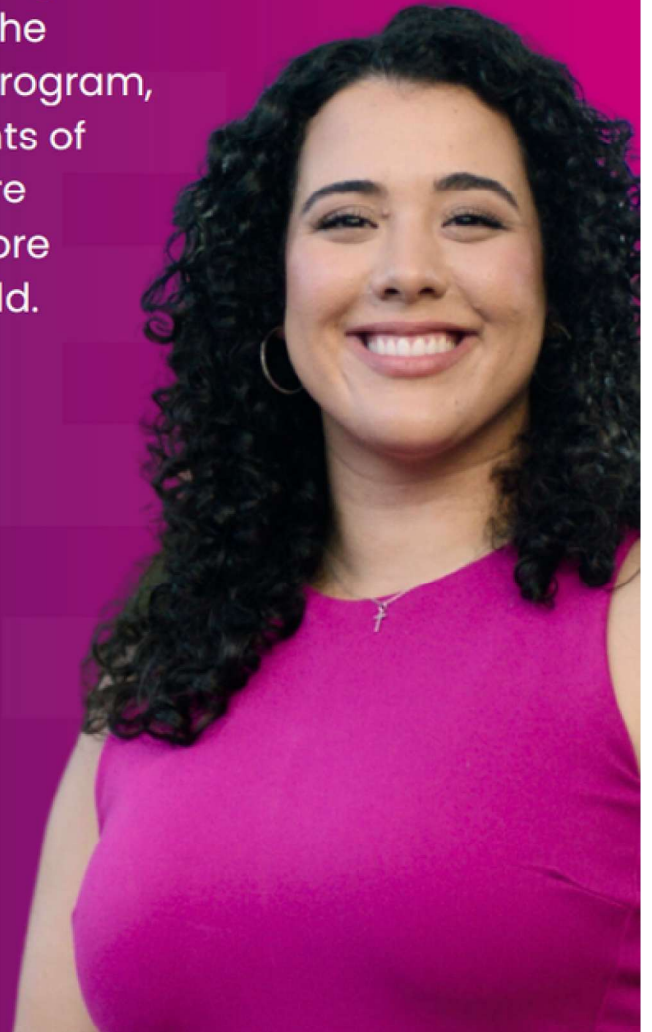
