Legislative Updates

SB 614: provides enhanced criminal penalties for persons who knowingly commit assault or battery upon hospital personnel.

Passed Criminal Justice on February 16th!

SB 700: authorizing telehealth providers to prescribe specified controlled substances through telehealth under certain circumstances.


Passed Health Policy on February 17th!

SB 58: Repeals a provision relating to reporting community benefit expenses for property exemption purposes.




