Veto Updates

Earlier this month, Governor DeSantis vetoed approximately **\$567 million** from the state budget, affecting a broad range of programs and projects across Florida. The vetoes impacted initiatives focused on infrastructure improvements, community nonprofits, educational programming, and storm preparedness.

Despite these significant cuts, our office is proud to report that **over \$10 million in critical funding was successfully secured for our region**. These investments will continue to support key priorities and bring meaningful improvements to our community.

Each day, they serve nearly 500 people in their residential programs and support over 100 more through drop-in community services, such as shower access, meals, hygiene supplies, and case-managed housing plans.
