## **Animal Cruelty Month**

April is prevention of cruelty to animals month and we wanted to highlight the legislation Senator Arrington has filed and cosponsored to address this issue.

• SB 1732 Criminal Justice by Senator Arrington

- This bill will create penalties for adults who entice or force a minor to commit, or in the presence of a minor, an act of animal cruelty. Acts of animal cruelty include fighting or baiting animals and sexual activities involving animals.
- <u>SB 150</u> Abandoning Restrained Dogs During Natural Disasters by Senator Gaetz; co-sponsor Senator Arrington
  - This bill will create penalties for anyone who leaves an animal restrained during a natural disaster.
- <u>SB 494</u> Aggravated Animal Cruelty By Senator Leek; cosponsor Senator Arrington
  - This bill will create a registry of individuals who committed certain acts of animal cruelty.
- <u>SB 502</u> Animal Cruelty Offenses By Senator Leek; cosponsor Senate Arrington
  - This bill would change some of the legal definitions of what a domestic animal is.
