Drones	 Requires the DMS to update the list of approved manufacturers of drones to purchase by government agencies Permits the DMS to grant waivers for purchase or acquisition of drones not on the approved manufacturers list if the public's interest is protected 	No substantive language	Adds rulemaking authority for DMS to adopt an approved list and establish a waiver process
