From the funds appropriated to the Division of Emergency Management within the Executive Office of the Governor in section 8 of chapter 2022-272, Laws of Florida, up to \$7,000,000 shall revert and is appropriated for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 to shall be used by the division to assist local governments with debris removal related to recovery from the impact of tornadic activity on January 9, 2024, and confirmed by the National Weather Service as significant on the Enhanced Fujita Scale. Such local governments must enter into agreements with the division to receive grants or reimbursements, as appropriate, of costs incurred related to debris activities, including wet debris.
