This project will collect stormwater that is currently being drained off into the ocean. This water will be directed to sheet flow through a created forested wetland- currently this property is a wet, floodplain, pasture. This water will be treated, primarily through a natural process, for nutrient removal. This cleaner water will then be allowed to pass into a 600 acre, leaky lake to recharge the aquifer. This project will create over 100 acres of new wildlife habitat. In order to allow the public to enjoy this habitat, walking and kayak trails will be created.

d. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

The land being purchased by this appropriation will be used to capture stormwater that was being drained off to the ocean, cleaning this water (nutrient removal), storing the water, and making it available for aquifer recharge.

e. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The population to be served by this project will be Polk County, which has been recently designated as a water region. Those who will be served are those who depend on the Floridan aquifer within this region.

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

By recharging the aquifer there will be more available water for municipal, private, and agricultural well owners. The recreational benefits will be enjoyed by locals, school educational visits, and by eco-tourism (much like the Circle B preserve). The success of this outcome can be measured using aquifer levels and attendance records.
