<u>The Cape Canaveral Lighthouse Foundation (CCLF) will use the funds to continue the lighthouse restoration</u> <u>activities by re-constructing the historically significant Lighthouse Keepers' Cottages and operating them as an</u> <u>historical, educational, and commemorative site for the public's use.</u>

b. What are the activities and services that will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

<u>The reconstruction would restore the historical configuration of the buildings surrounding the lighthouse that</u> <u>existed during the period 1868 to 1950.</u> The buildings will be used as (1) an education center, (2) a museumtype archeological center, (3) a replica Head Lighthouse Keeper's Cottage, and (4) a public restroom facility that will be built in the configuration of the original storage building.

d. What are the direct services to be provided to citizens by the appropriations project?

<u>The Keepers' Cottages are a unique education and tourist attraction for the community, the State of Florida</u> and our Nation.

e. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

<u>School children, local residents, and tourists, many of whom come to Brevard County via cruise ships (the second largest cruise port in the United States) are the targeted population.</u> Several thousand visitors are expected to tour this historical site.

f. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Provide the opportunity for students to learn about the history of the lighthouse, the fresnel lens operation, the difficulties that the Keepers and their families faced and the importance of lighthouses to the maritime community. Visitors will have an opportunity to experience the history of the Native Americans who resided in the area and their daily challenges. Outcome will be measured by increased student visits and bringing lighthouse history into the classrooms.
