The redesigned roadway will improve pedestrian connectivity, improve drainage, improve street lighting, add bus shelters, and landscaping. Items will be measured using Local Area Planning reporting standards.

Replacement of an existing obsolete bridge will necessitate improving the approaches to the bridge to make sure drainage can be managed properly. The roadway re-work will address that deficiency as well.

  \$1,000 per day (liquidated damages).
