The funds will be used to launch new programming for pre-teens ages (10-12) and enhance and grow programmatic opportunities for teens ages (13-19) in the most undeserved areas of Jacksonville. The goal is to provide these children with a safe space and constructive programming after school and in the summer as well as provide summer employment opportunities for teens. This will also provide additional part-time opportunities for qualified members of the community to work with teens at the new teen center.

State funds in combination with local grant dollars and private gifts will provide the funds necessary to increase operations, and our capacity to provide programming to the additional children.

Services will include life skills training, job and career preparation, health education, and social and emotional skills training.

 - At risk youth ages 10-19, high school students, victims of crime, persons with poor physical health, jobless persons, economically disadvantaged persons. Approximately 100-150 people will be served.

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We anticipate the following as a result of dollars provided to support this project: Protect the general public from harm- Any teens or members of the community/YMCA who utilize the YMCA regularly will be less likely to engage in criminal activities and thus protect the general public from any further harm. Teen criminal records will be searched at the beginning of the program as a term of program participation and throughout participation. Improved physical health- Health and wellness opportunities will be made available for all teens in the community. Members and nonmembers of the YMCA will take quantifiable self-assessments that allow them to self-identify if their health is better because of the program availability. Enrich cultural experience-Teens would have more than five cultural experiences as a part of the program. (Email for more information)
