Ch. 267.1735 requires that UF ensure the long-term preservation of state-owned historic properties in St. Augustine. A shortage in annual maintenance funding does not allow for repair and replacement of roofs for properties. Ex: Historic preservation standards require that wood-shake roofs be replaced with wooden shakes (2x the cost). A recurring appropriation of \$250,000 per year, will be used to implement a 5-year plan for roof replacement and also provide for future maintenance of such.
