Project will serve more than 2,500 military veteran students.

This will be measured by a quantitative count of students successfully retained as well as a count of this population who completed their credential. Further, it will improve the economic activity in the service area through the attainment of a job with a sustainable family wage, which will be measured by the number of Veterans placed into the workforce.
