Fire Station 75 and Ocean Rescue Headquarters located at 71 SE 21 Avenue, Deerfield Beach, was built in 1973 is in grave need of reconstruction. Located on the west side of S. Ocean Way, directly facing the Atlantic Ocean, the severe weather conditions associated with oceanfront property have deteriorated the structure at an accelerated pace. Moving the facility further west will shelter the facility from the weather elements it currently faces and will also increase response time by providing direct access to Hillsboro Blvd, a major roadway.
